HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION 2001
early childhood development; health; repeal

ANALYSIS BY LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

1 Proposition ____ would:

2 1. Redirect the ongoing tobacco tax revenues that are currently deposited in the
3 Early Childhood Development and Health fund for deposit in the state general fund, to be
4 separately accounted for and appropriated for health and human services for children.

5 2. Transfer any remaining uncommitted Early Childhood Development and
6 Health fund monies to the state general fund on December 1, 2010.

7 3. Terminate the Arizona Early Childhood Development and Health Board on
8 December 1, 2010.

9 4. Repeal the Early Childhood Development and Health program statutes on June
10 1, 2011.

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12 The Early Childhood Development and Health Fund consists of revenues
13 generated by an \$.80 per pack tax on tobacco products and donations and state
14 appropriations. The fund is administered by the Arizona Early Childhood Development
15 and Health Board and is required to be used for the following purposes:

16 1. Funding central and field offices, employing staff and establishing and
17 appointing regional partnership councils, which make funding recommendations to the
18 Board.

19 2. Disbursing monies for programs and grants that increase the quality of and
20 access to early childhood development and health services for children up to five years of
21 age and their families.
