HOUSE BILL 2706

AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 15, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING CHAPTER 19; RELATING
TO ARIZONA EMPOWERMENT ACCOUNTS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 15, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended by adding
3 chapter 19, to read:

4 CHAPTER 19

5 ARIZONA EMPOWERMENT ACCOUNTS

6 ARTICLE 1. GENERAL PROVISIONS

7 15-2401. Definitions

8 IN THIS CHAPTER, UNLESS THE CONTEXT OTHERWISE REQUIRES:

9 1. "DEPARTMENT" MEANS THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION.

10 2. "ELIGIBLE POSTSECONDARY INSTITUTION" MEANS A COMMUNITY COLLEGE AS
11 DEFINED IN SECTION 15-1401, A UNIVERSITY UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE
12 ARIZONA BOARD OF REGENTS OR AN ACCREDITED PRIVATE POSTSECONDARY INSTITUTION.

13 3. "PARENT" MEANS A RESIDENT OF THIS STATE WHO IS THE PARENT OR LEGAL
14 GUARDIAN OF A QUALIFIED STUDENT.

15 4. "QUALIFIED SCHOOL" MEANS A NONGOVERNMENTAL PRIMARY OR SECONDARY
16 SCHOOL OR A PRESCHOOL FOR HANDICAPPED STUDENTS THAT IS LOCATED IN THIS STATE
17 AND THAT DOES NOT DISCRIMINATE ON THE BASIS OF RACE, COLOR OR NATIONAL
18 ORIGIN.

19 5. "QUALIFIED STUDENT" MEANS A RESIDENT OF THIS STATE WHO IS EITHER
20 IDENTIFIED AS HAVING A DISABILITY UNDER SECTION 504 OF THE REHABILITATION ACT
21 (29 UNITED STATES CODE SECTION 794), IDENTIFIED BY A SCHOOL DISTRICT AS A
22 CHILD WITH A DISABILITY AS DEFINED IN SECTION 15-761 OR A CHILD WITH A
23 DISABILITY WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE SERVICES FROM A SCHOOL DISTRICT UNDER
24 SECTION 15-763 AND WHO DID ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:

25 (a) ATTENDED A GOVERNMENTAL PRIMARY OR SECONDARY SCHOOL AS A FULL-TIME
26 STUDENT AS DEFINED IN SECTION 15-901 FOR AT LEAST THE FIRST ONE HUNDRED DAYS
27 OF THE PRIOR FISCAL YEAR AND WHO TRANSFERRED FROM A GOVERNMENTAL PRIMARY OR
28 SECONDARY SCHOOL TO A QUALIFIED SCHOOL.

29 (b) PARTICIPATED IN THE EMPOWERMENT ACCOUNT PROGRAM IN THE PREVIOUS
30 YEAR AND WHOSE PARENT RENEWS THE AGREEMENT PURSUANT TO SECTION 15-2402,
31 SUBSECTION B.

32 (c) RECEIVED A SCHOLARSHIP UNDER SECTION 43-1505 AND WHO CONTINUES TO
33 ATTEND A QUALIFIED SCHOOL.

34 6. "TREASURER" MEANS THE OFFICE OF THE STATE TREASURER.

35 15-2402. Arizona empowerment accounts

36 A. ARIZONA EMPOWERMENT ACCOUNTS ARE ESTABLISHED TO PROVIDE OPTIONS FOR
37 THE EDUCATION OF STUDENTS IN THIS STATE.

38 B. TO ENROLL A QUALIFIED STUDENT FOR AN EMPOWERMENT ACCOUNT, THE
39 PARENT OF THE QUALIFIED STUDENT MUST SIGN AN AGREEMENT TO DO ALL OF THE
40 FOLLOWING:

41 1. PROVIDE AN EDUCATION FOR THE QUALIFIED STUDENT IN AT LEAST THE
42 SUBJECTS OF READING, GRAMMAR, MATHEMATICS, SOCIAL STUDIES AND SCIENCE.

43 2. NOT ENROLL THE QUALIFIED STUDENT IN A SCHOOL DISTRICT OR CHARTER
44 SCHOOL AND RELEASE THE SCHOOL DISTRICT FROM ALL OBLIGATIONS TO EDUCATE THE
45 QUALIFIED STUDENT.

1 3. NOT ACCEPT A SCHOLARSHIP FROM A SCHOOL TUITION ORGANIZATION
2 PURSUANT TO TITLE 43 FOR THE QUALIFIED STUDENT.
3 4. USE THE MONEY DEPOSITED IN THE QUALIFIED STUDENT'S ARIZONA
4 EMPOWERMENT ACCOUNT ONLY FOR THE FOLLOWING EXPENSES OF THE QUALIFIED STUDENT:
5 (a) TUITION OR FEES AT A QUALIFIED SCHOOL.
6 (b) TEXTBOOKS REQUIRED BY A QUALIFIED SCHOOL.
7 (c) EDUCATIONAL THERAPIES OR SERVICES FOR THE QUALIFIED STUDENT FROM A
8 LICENSED OR ACCREDITED PRACTITIONER OR PROVIDER.
9 (d) TUTORING SERVICES PROVIDED BY A TUTOR ACCREDITED BY A STATE,
10 REGIONAL OR NATIONAL ACCREDITING ORGANIZATION.
11 (e) CURRICULUM.
12 (f) TUITION OR FEES FOR A NONPUBLIC ONLINE LEARNING PROGRAM.
13 (g) FEES FOR A NATIONALLY STANDARDIZED NORM-REFERENCED ACHIEVEMENT
14 TEST, ADVANCED PLACEMENT EXAMINATIONS OR ANY EXAMS RELATED TO COLLEGE OR
15 UNIVERSITY ADMISSION.
16 (h) CONTRIBUTIONS TO A QUALIFIED TUITION PROGRAM ESTABLISHED PURSUANT
17 TO 11 UNITED STATES CODE SECTION 529.
18 (i) TUITION OR FEES AT AN ELIGIBLE POSTSECONDARY INSTITUTION.
19 (j) TEXTBOOKS REQUIRED BY AN ELIGIBLE POSTSECONDARY INSTITUTION.
20 (k) FEES FOR MANAGEMENT OF THE EMPOWERMENT ACCOUNT BY FIRMS SELECTED
21 BY THE DEPARTMENT.
22 C. IN EXCHANGE FOR THE PARENT'S AGREEMENT PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION B OF
23 THIS SECTION, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL TRANSFER TO THE TREASURER FOR DEPOSIT INTO
24 AN ARIZONA EMPOWERMENT ACCOUNT AN AMOUNT THAT IS EQUIVALENT TO NINETY PER
25 CENT OF THE BASE SUPPORT LEVEL PRESCRIBED IN SECTION 15-943 FOR THAT
26 PARTICULAR STUDENT.
27 D. A PARENT MUST RENEW THE QUALIFIED STUDENT'S EMPOWERMENT ACCOUNT ON
28 AN ANNUAL BASIS.
29 E. A SIGNED AGREEMENT UNDER THIS SECTION CONSTITUTES SCHOOL ATTENDANCE
30 REQUIRED BY SECTION 15-802.
31 F. A QUALIFIED SCHOOL OR A PROVIDER OF SERVICES PURCHASED PURSUANT TO
32 SUBSECTION B, PARAGRAPH 4 OF THIS SECTION MAY NOT SHARE, REFUND OR REBATE ANY
33 ARIZONA EMPOWERMENT ACCOUNT MONIES WITH THE PARENT OR QUALIFIED CHILD IN ANY
34 MANNER.
35 G. ON THE QUALIFIED STUDENT'S GRADUATION FROM A POSTSECONDARY
36 INSTITUTION OR AFTER ANY PERIOD OF FOUR CONSECUTIVE YEARS AFTER HIGH SCHOOL
37 GRADUATION IN WHICH THE STUDENT IS NOT ENROLLED IN AN ELIGIBLE POSTSECONDARY
38 INSTITUTION, THE QUALIFIED STUDENT'S ARIZONA EMPOWERMENT ACCOUNT SHALL BE
39 CLOSED AND ANY REMAINING FUNDS SHALL BE RETURNED TO THE STATE.
40 15-2403. Empowerment accounts; administration; audit; rules
41 A. THE TREASURER MAY CONTRACT WITH PRIVATE FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT FIRMS
42 TO MANAGE ARIZONA EMPOWERMENT ACCOUNTS WITH THE SUPERVISION OF THE TREASURER.
43 B. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL CONDUCT OR CONTRACT FOR ANNUAL AUDITS OF A
44 RANDOM SAMPLE OF EMPOWERMENT ACCOUNTS TO ENSURE COMPLIANCE WITH SECTION
45 15-2402, SUBSECTION B, PARAGRAPH 4. THE DEPARTMENT MAY ALSO CONDUCT OR

1 CONTRACT FOR AUDITS OF EMPOWERMENT ACCOUNTS AS NEEDED TO ENSURE COMPLIANCE
2 WITH SECTION 15-2402, SUBSECTION B, PARAGRAPH 4.

3 C. THE DEPARTMENT MAY REMOVE ANY PARENT OR QUALIFIED STUDENT FROM
4 ELIGIBILITY FOR AN ARIZONA EMPOWERMENT ACCOUNT AND SHALL NOTIFY THE
5 TREASURER. A PARENT MAY APPEAL THE DEPARTMENT'S DECISION PURSUANT TO TITLE
6 41, CHAPTER 6, ARTICLE 10.

7 D. THE DEPARTMENT MAY REFER CASES OF SUBSTANTIAL MISUSE OF MONIES TO
8 THE ATTORNEY GENERAL FOR INVESTIGATION IF THE DEPARTMENT OBTAINS EVIDENCE OF
9 FRAUDULENT USE OF AN ACCOUNT.

10 E. THE TREASURER MAY DEDUCT UP TO THREE PER CENT OF THE AMOUNT OF
11 STUDENT STATE AID FROM EACH EMPOWERMENT ACCOUNT FOR THE COSTS OF
12 ADMINISTERING EMPOWERMENT ACCOUNTS UNDER THIS CHAPTER, INCLUDING COSTS
13 INCURRED BY THE DEPARTMENT.

14 F. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL MAKE QUARTERLY TRANSFERS OF THE AMOUNT
15 CALCULATED PURSUANT TO SECTION 15-2402, SUBSECTION C TO THE TREASURER FOR
16 DEPOSIT INTO THE EMPOWERMENT ACCOUNT OF EACH QUALIFIED STUDENT.

17 G. THE DEPARTMENT MAY ADOPT RULES NECESSARY FOR THE ADMINISTRATION OF
18 EMPOWERMENT ACCOUNTS.

19 15-2404. State control over nonpublic schools; prohibition;
20 application

21 A. THIS CHAPTER DOES NOT PERMIT ANY GOVERNMENT AGENCY TO EXERCISE
22 CONTROL OR SUPERVISION OVER ANY NONPUBLIC SCHOOL OR HOME SCHOOL.

23 B. A QUALIFIED SCHOOL THAT ACCEPTS A PAYMENT FROM A PARENT PURSUANT TO
24 THIS CHAPTER IS NOT AN AGENT OF THE STATE OR FEDERAL GOVERNMENT.

25 C. A QUALIFIED SCHOOL SHALL NOT BE REQUIRED TO ALTER ITS CREED,
26 PRACTICES, ADMISSIONS POLICY OR CURRICULUM IN ORDER TO ACCEPT STUDENTS WHOSE
27 PARENTS PAY TUITION OR FEES FROM AN EMPOWERMENT ACCOUNT PURSUANT TO THIS
28 CHAPTER IN ORDER TO PARTICIPATE AS A QUALIFIED SCHOOL.

29 D. IN ANY LEGAL PROCEEDING CHALLENGING THE APPLICATION OF THIS CHAPTER
30 TO A QUALIFIED SCHOOL, THE STATE BEARS THE BURDEN OF ESTABLISHING THAT THE
31 LAW IS NECESSARY AND DOES NOT IMPOSE ANY UNDUE BURDEN ON QUALIFIED SCHOOLS.

32 Sec. 2. Arizona empowerment accounts; agreements

33 For the 2011 fall semester, the deadline for parents to sign an
34 agreement with the department is August 1, 2011. For the 2012 spring
35 semester, the deadline is December 1, 2011. The department has up to thirty
36 days to process agreements and notify the treasurer of the total number of
37 qualified students who have properly filled out the agreements for
38 empowerment accounts.
