SENATE BILL 1548

AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 30, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING CHAPTER 2; RELATING TO
NUCLEAR FUEL RECYCLING.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:
2 Section 1. Title 30, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended by adding
3 chapter 2, to read:

4 CHAPTER 2

5 NUCLEAR FUEL RECYCLING

6 ARTICLE 1. GENERAL PROVISIONS

7 30-301. Nuclear fuel recycling; facility fees; nuclear
8 recycling public school fund

9 A. IF A NUCLEAR FUEL RECYCLING FACILITY IS ESTABLISHED IN THIS STATE,
10 THE FOLLOWING APPLY:

11 1. THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT SHALL PAY FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE NUCLEAR
12 FUEL RECYCLING FACILITY.

13 2. THE OPERATION OF THE NUCLEAR FUEL RECYCLING FACILITY SHALL BE A
14 JOINT VENTURE BETWEEN THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT, THIS STATE AND A PRIVATE
15 ENTITY.

16 3. THIS STATE SHALL CHARGE THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT A NEGOTIATED FEE PER
17 UNIT OF FUEL FOR THE RIGHT TO DEVELOP THIS FACILITY. ALL FEES COLLECTED
18 SHALL BE DEPOSITED IN THE NUCLEAR RECYCLING PUBLIC SCHOOL FUND ESTABLISHED BY
19 THIS SECTION.

20 B. THE NUCLEAR RECYCLING PUBLIC SCHOOL FUND IS ESTABLISHED FOR THE
21 SUPPORT AND MAINTENANCE OF PUBLIC SCHOOLS, INCLUDING KINDERGARTEN PROGRAMS,
22 GRADES ONE THROUGH TWELVE, COMMUNITY COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES. THE STATE
23 TREASURER SHALL ADMINISTER THE FUND. THE FUND SHALL CONSIST OF MONIES
24 COLLECTED PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION A. MONIES IN THE FUND ARE SUBJECT TO
25 LEGISLATIVE APPROPRIATION. MONIES IN THE FUND ARE INTENDED TO OFFSET STATE
26 GENERAL FUND EXPENDITURES FOR PUBLIC EDUCATION.
