(Reference to House engrossed Senate bill)

1 Page 1, between lines 1 and 2, insert:

2 "Section 1. Section 32-2211, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended  
3 to read:

4 32-2211. Exceptions from application of chapter

5 This chapter ~~shall~~ DOES not apply to:

6 1. A commissioned veterinary medical officer of the United States  
7 armed services,~~;~~ or employees of the animal disease eradication division  
8 of the United States department of agriculture.

9 2. A person ~~treating~~ WHO TREATS an animal belonging to ~~himself~~  
10 THE PERSON or ~~his~~ THE PERSON'S employer while in the regular service of  
11 ~~such~~ THAT employer,~~;~~ or the animal of another without compensation  
12 ~~therefor~~. Animals consigned by their legal owner for feeding or care to  
13 consignment livestock operations shall be considered to be the property  
14 of the consignee.

15 3. A licensed veterinarian of another state or foreign country  
16 ~~consulting~~ WHO CONSULTS with a licensed veterinarian in this state.

17 4. A veterinary student who performs acts of health care or  
18 prescribed veterinary procedures as a part of the VETERINARY student's  
19 educational experience if both of the following apply:

20 (a) The acts are assigned by a licensed veterinarian or a  
21 licensed veterinary faculty member who is responsible for the animal's  
22 care.

23 (b) The VETERINARY student works under the direct supervision of  
24 a licensed veterinarian or a licensed veterinary faculty member.

25 5. A veterinary assistant WHO IS employed by a licensed  
26 veterinarian ~~performing~~ AND WHO PERFORMS duties other than diagnosis,

1 prognosis, prescription or surgery under the direct supervision or  
2 indirect supervision of ~~such~~ THE LICENSED veterinarian who ~~shall be~~ IS  
3 responsible for ~~such~~ THE VETERINARY assistant's performance.

4 6. AN EMERGENCY MEDICAL CARE TECHNICIAN WHO PROVIDES EMERGENCY  
5 TREATMENT PURSUANT TO SECTION 36-2230.

6 7. A PHYSICIAN WHO IS LICENSED PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 13 OR 17 OF  
7 THIS TITLE AND WHO PROVIDES ADMINISTRATIVE MEDICAL DIRECTION AS DEFINED  
8 IN SECTION 36-2201 OR ONLINE MEDICAL DIRECTION WITHIN THE EMERGENCY  
9 MEDICAL SERVICES AND TRAUMA SYSTEM TO AN EMERGENCY MEDICAL CARE  
10 TECHNICIAN WHO IS PROVIDING EMERGENCY TREATMENT PURSUANT TO SECTION  
11 36-2230.

26 Line 21, after "TRANSPORT" insert "BY THE GROUND AMBULANCE OR OTHER  
27 EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES VEHICLE"

28 Between lines 21 and 22, insert:

29 "2. THE TRANSPORT IS NOT EXPECTED TO TAKE MORE THAN THIRTY  
30 MINUTES FROM THE POINT OF PICKUP TO THE VETERINARY CLINIC OR VETERINARY  
31 HOSPITAL.

1           3. THE AMBULANCE SERVICE HAS AT LEAST ONE ADDITIONAL GROUND  
2           AMBULANCE IN SERVICE AND AVAILABLE TO RESPOND TO EMERGENCY CALLS.

3           4. THE TRANSPORT BY A POLICE OFFICER IN THE POLICE OFFICER'S  
4           EMERGENCY VEHICLE IS NOT DEEMED TO BE MORE SAFE AND MORE EXPEDITIOUS  
5           THAN TRANSPORT BY A GROUND AMBULANCE.

6           B. AN AMBULANCE SERVICE MAY AUTHORIZE ITS EMERGENCY MEDICAL CARE  
7           TECHNICIANS, IF TRAINED, TO PROVIDE EMERGENCY TREATMENT TO A POLICE DOG  
8           THAT IS INJURED IN THE LINE OF DUTY."

10 Page 9, line 30, strike "BOX"

11       Lines 38 and 40, strike "AN" insert "A GROUND"

12       Line 42, after "THE" insert "GROUND"

13 Page 10, between lines 4 and 5, insert:

14           "E. AN AMBULANCE SERVICE THAT PROVIDES TRANSPORT FOR AN INJURED  
15           POLICE DOG PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION MAY BILL THE GOVERNMENTAL ENTITY  
16           THAT OWNS THE POLICE DOG FOR THE COST OF THE TRANSPORT.

17           F. THIS SECTION DOES NOT PRECLUDE A POLICE OFFICER WHO IS TRAINED  
18           IN DOG HANDLING OF AN INJURED POLICE DOG FROM CHOOSING TO TRANSPORT THE  
19           INJURED POLICE DOG IN THE POLICE OFFICER'S OWN EMERGENCY VEHICLE."
