I have vetoed HB2545.

This bill would severely limit the ability of the state to respond in times of crisis. It unnecessarily politicizes what are often life or death situations, and adds an irresponsible burden of regulatory loopholes for the state to jump through during an emerging public health threat.

It is our shared constitutional duty as government employees to preserve the health and welfare of Arizonans. My administration will always follow the guidance of scientific and epidemiological experts when it comes to safeguarding our state against emergent threats, and I refuse to allow the legislature to play political games at the expense of human lives.
