## **COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATIONS**

**Representative Smith moved that the Committee recommend that the Legislature revisit our statutes and ensure that enforceable policy is in place in each of the following areas:**

- 1. Free expression policies must apply not only to students but also to administrators, faculty, and staff.**
- 2. Universities must enforce their free expression policies. Having a policy statement without actionable accountability measures does not provide students with the protection they deserve.**

- 3. Students must be assured that their decision to listen to or participate in any form of protected speech will not have negative effects on classroom grades.**
- 4. While Arizona law allows the Board of Regents to delegate some of its responsibilities to the respective state university presidents, the Board must remain responsible to take care that each of the public universities are faithfully executing and enforcing their duties.**

**The motion carried with a roll call vote of 6-0-4 (Attachment 1).**

Representatives Carter, Crews, Smith, Senators Wadsack and Kern explained their vote.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 1:51 p.m.
