AMENDING SECTION 13-2919, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO OFFENSES AGAINST PUBLIC ORDER.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 13-2919, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 13-2919. Automated telephone solicitation: violation:
5 classification

6 A. A person shall not use an automated system for the selection and
7 dialing of telephone numbers and the playing of a recorded message **OR SENDING**
8 **A TEXT MESSAGE** for the purpose of soliciting persons to purchase goods or
9 services or requesting survey information if the results are to be used
10 directly for the purpose of soliciting persons to purchase goods or services.

11 B. **THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY IF A RECORDED MESSAGE OR TEXT MESSAGE**
12 **IS RECEIVED UNDER ANY OF THE FOLLOWING CIRCUMSTANCES:**

13 1. **WITH PRIOR EXPRESS INVITATION OR PERMISSION BY THE RECIPIENT.**

14 2. **BY A RECIPIENT WHO HAS AN EXISTING BUSINESS RELATIONSHIP WITH THE**
15 **SENDER.**

16 ~~B.~~ C. A person who violates this section is guilty of a class 2
17 misdemeanor.
