

HOUSE FLOOR AMENDMENT EXPLANATION



Bill Number: **SB 1337**

Barton Floor Amendment

1. Declares that the regulation of industrial hemp does not authorize a person to violate any federal law or regulation.
2. Prohibits the ADA Director from licensing a grower or processor unless:
 - a. the grower or processor obtains a valid controlled substance registration from the DEA, if required by federal law; or
 - b. the possession, use, sale, production, manufacturing or transportation of industrial hemp is permitted by federal law.
3. Removes language prohibiting the adoption of a rule that would prohibit a person from growing industrial hemp based on the federal legal status of industrial hemp.
4. Modifies the purpose statement.

- 3 OF RESEARCH INTO THE GROWTH, CULTIVATION AND MARKETING OF INDUSTRIAL HEMP

- 5 Page 2, line 2, after the period strike remainder of line
- 6 Strike lines 3 and 4, insert:

7 "THIS ARTICLE DOES NOT AUTHORIZE ANY PERSON TO VIOLATE ANY FEDERAL
8 LAW OR REGULATION. THE DIRECTOR MAY NOT LICENSE A GROWER OR PROCESSOR
9 UNLESS THE GROWER OR PROCESSOR FIRST OBTAINS A VALID CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE
10 REGISTRATION FROM THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, DRUG ENFORCEMENT
11 ADMINISTRATION, IF REQUIRED UNDER FEDERAL LAW, OR THE POSSESSION, USE,
12 SALE, PRODUCTION, MANUFACTURING OR TRANSPORTATION OF INDUSTRIAL HEMP IS
13 PERMITTED BY FEDERAL LAW."
- 14 Amend title to conform
