HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION 2029

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

COMMENDING THE AGENTS OF THE UNITED STATES BORDER PATROL.

1 Whereas, the southern border consists of 1,993 miles of varied
2 terrain, including deserts, rugged mountainous areas, forests and coastal
3 areas; and

4 Whereas, officially established in 1924 by an act of Congress in
5 response to increasing illegal immigration, the United States Border
6 Patrol has primary responsibility for securing the border between ports of
7 entry; and

8 Whereas, Border Patrol agents patrol international land borders and
9 waterways to detect and prevent the illegal trafficking of people,
10 narcotics and contraband into the United States; and

11 Whereas, the southern border of the United States is experiencing
12 unprecedeted numbers of individuals attempting to enter the country
13 illegally; and

14 Whereas, in June 2019, over 100,000 individuals were apprehended at
15 the southern border, which is an increase of more than 140% as compared to
16 June 2018; and

17 Whereas, the Border Patrol establishes and maintains partnerships
18 with local, state, federal, tribal and international law enforcement
19 partners, as well as local ranchers and other private citizens who own
20 much of the land along the southwest border; and

21 Whereas, Border Patrol agents work in dynamic environments with
22 multiple and varied threats that are constantly changing and evolving; and

23 Whereas, Border Patrol agents responded admirably to the COVID-19
24 pandemic, efficiently implementing the resulting new policies and
25 procedures to ensure the safety of the public; and

26 Whereas, the Border Patrol protects the United States against
27 terrorists and instruments of terror; and

28 Whereas, created in 2003, the United States Immigration and Customs
29 Enforcement (ICE) conducts transnational criminal investigations to
30 identify and interdict myriad smuggling and cross-border illegal activity.
31 The work of ICE is critical to enforcing immigration law against people
32 who present a threat to national security, are a danger to public safety
33 or undermine the integrity of the immigration system; and

34 Whereas, demonstrating courage and valor in protecting our nation,
35 Border Patrol agents serve the American people with vigilance, integrity
36 and professionalism.

37 Therefore

38 Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of Arizona,
39 the Senate concurring:

40 1. That the Members of the Legislature commend the courage,
41 dedication and sacrifice of the men and women of the United States Border
42 Patrol and recognize the vital role they play in safeguarding our state
43 and nation.

44 2. That the Secretary of State of the State of Arizona transmit
45 copies of this Resolution to the President of the United States and each
46 Member of Congress from the State of Arizona.
