1 Page 1, line 6, strike "NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER LAW,"

2 Between lines 7 and 8, insert:

3 "B. MATERIALS MAY BE EXEMPTED FROM THE PROVISIONS OF SUBSECTION A IF

4 ALL OF THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS ARE MET:

5 1. THE EXEMPTED MATERIAL IS ONE OF THE FOLLOWING:

6 (a) CLASSICAL LITERATURE.

7 (b) EARLY AMERICAN LITERATURE.

8 (c) A REQUIRED BOOK FOR A COURSE TO OBTAIN COLLEGE CREDIT.

9 2. THE PUBLIC SCHOOL REQUIRES WRITTEN PARENTAL CONSENT BEFORE THE  
10 PUBLIC SCHOOL REFERS A STUDENT TO OR USES THE EXEMPTED MATERIAL. THE PUBLIC  
11 SCHOOL SHALL REQUIRE PARENTAL CONSENT ON A PER-MATERIAL BASIS.

12 3. THE PUBLIC SCHOOL SHALL PROVIDE STUDENTS FOR WHOM PARENTAL  
13 CONSENT IS NOT SECURED UNDER PARAGRAPH 2 OF THIS SUBSECTION WITH AN  
14 ALTERNATIVE ASSIGNMENT THAT DOES NOT CONTAIN SEXUALLY EXPLICIT MATERIAL."
