**AN ACT**

**AMENDING SECTION 9-812, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO MUNICIPAL ORDINANCES.**

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:  
2 Section 1. Section 9-812, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to  
3 read:  
4 9-812. Publication and posting of notices and ordinances;  
5 applicability  
6 A. Notices of election, invitations for bids, notices of letting  
7 contracts, laws and ordinances, ~~and~~ and other notices of a public character  
8 issued by authority of the governing body of any city or town, ~~shall be~~  
9 POSTED ON THE CITY'S OR TOWN'S WEBSITE OR published in one of the  
10 following:  
11 1. A newspaper that is printed and published within the city or  
12 town.  
13 2. A newspaper THAT IS printed and published within the county in  
14 which the city or town is located with a greater circulation to residents  
15 of the city or town.  
16 B. A CITY OR TOWN THAT POSTS NOTICES ON THE CITY'S OR TOWN'S  
17 WEBSITE SHALL PROVIDE ON THE WEBSITE'S HOME PAGE A LINK TO A LISTING OF  
18 ALL CURRENT NOTICES AND ORDINANCES.  
19 ~~B.~~ C. In cases of laws or ordinances enacted on behalf of a  
20 private person, ~~he~~ THE PRIVATE PERSON shall pay the expense of  
21 publication, ~~and~~ and may designate the newspaper.  
22 ~~C.~~ D. ~~Subsection~~ SUBSECTIONS A AND B of this section ~~shall further~~  
23 apply to notices and resolutions that require newspaper publication under  
24 title 48, chapter 4 unless otherwise stated in title 48.
