FLOOR AMENDMENT EXPLANATION

- 1. Exempts poll workers using an electronic pollbook to check in voters from the requirement that employees, contractors and volunteers who log in to an election system have a unique password that is changed every two weeks.**
- 2. Requires a person to knowingly violate requirements related to election system passwords in order to be guilty of a class 2 misdemeanor.**
- 3. Exempts the 30 days before an election from the requirement that each employee, contractor or volunteer that logs in to an election system establish a new unique password every two weeks.**
