FLOOR AMENDMENT EXPLANATION

- 1. Requires the automated crime victim notification system to automatically, and without the requirement to download a software application or to opt in to notifications, notify the victim by email or text of all of the outlined information regarding a victim's law enforcement crime report, investigation and case.**
- 2. Removes the Prosecutor Crime Victim Notification Fund and outlined requirements relating to the software the Fund monies must be spent on.**
- 3. Increases the appropriation to the Law Enforcement Crime Victim Notification Fund from \$3,600,000 to \$3,800,000.**
- 4. Removes the \$1,500,000 appropriation to the Prosecutor Crime Victim Notification Fund.**
- 5. Appropriates \$1,400,000 from the state General Fund in FY 2023 to the Victims' Rights Fund.**
- 6. Makes technical and conforming changes.**
