FLOOR AMENDMENT EXPLANATION

- 1. Reinstates the specification that the state aid formula for community college STEM and workforce programs is subject to appropriation.**
- 2. Caps, at one percent of the community college district's budget, the amount of state aid that may be withheld for exceeding the expenditure limit for a provisional community college district established before December 31, 2015, in a county with a population that does not exceed 300,000 persons.**
- 3. Specifies that the FY 2023 state aid for STEM and workforce development programs for the Maricopa, Pima and Pinal CCDs is as prescribed in this legislation.**
- 4. Makes conforming changes.**
