AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 13-2909, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO RESIDENTIAL PICKETING.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:
2 Section 1. Section 13-2909, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 13-2909. Residential picketing; classification

5 A. A person commits residential picketing if, with intent to
6 harass, annoy or alarm another person **OR IF THE ACTIONS ARE SUCH THAT A**
REASONABLE PERSON WOULD FIND THE ACTS HARASSING, ANNOYING OR ALARMING,
7 **such THE** person intentionally engages in picketing or otherwise
8 demonstrates before or about the residence or dwelling place of an
9 individual, other than a residence or dwelling place also used as the
10 principal place of business of **such THE** individual.

12 B. Residential picketing is a class 3 misdemeanor.
