## AN ACT

REPEALING TITLE 36, CHAPTER 6, ARTICLE 4.2, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES;  
AMENDING TITLE 36, CHAPTER 6, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING A NEW  
ARTICLE 4.2; RELATING TO PUBLIC HEALTH CONTROL.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Repeal

3 Title 36, chapter 6, article 4.2, Arizona Revised Statutes, is  
4 repealed.

5 Sec. 2. Title 36, chapter 6, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended  
6 by adding a new article 4.2, to read:

7 ARTICLE 4.2. PUBLIC HEALTH MANDATES

8 36-681. Exemptions from COVID-19 vaccination; requirements

9 A PERSON IS ELIGIBLE FOR AN EXEMPTION FROM ANY VACCINATION  
10 REQUIREMENT FOR COVID-19 OR ANY VARIANT OF COVID-19 THAT IS BEING ENFORCED  
11 IN THIS STATE IF THE PERSON CAN PRODUCE DOCUMENTED TEST RESULTS THAT  
12 DEMONSTRATE THE PERSON HAS ONE OF THE FOLLOWING:

- 13 1. ANTIBODIES TO COVID-19 OR ANY VARIANT OF COVID-19.
- 14 2. A POSITIVE TEST FOR COVID-19 OR ANY VARIANT OF COVID-19.
- 15 3. A POSITIVE T-CELL IMMUNE RESPONSE TO COVID-19 OR ANY VARIANT OF  
16 COVID-19.
