AN ACT

PROVIDING FOR THE PLACEMENT OF A MORMON MIGRATION MONUMENT IN THE GOVERNMENTAL MALL.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Mormon migration monument; procedures; delayed
3 repeal

4 A. Pursuant to section 41-1363, subsection A, Arizona Revised
5 Statutes, this act authorizes the department of administration to provide
6 for the placement of a Mormon migration monument in the governmental mall.

7 B. The procedures prescribed in section 41-1363, subsection B,
8 Arizona Revised Statutes, apply to the placement of the monument.

9 C. Public monies are not authorized for the costs of the placement
10 of the monument. All fundraising and contracts for artistic design and
11 construction of the monument are the sole responsibility of the
12 proponents. This state may not facilitate fundraising or establish a
13 state fund for the deposit of the monies.

14 D. This section is repealed from and after September 30, 2025.
