AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 9-812, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO MUNICIPAL ORDINANCES.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 9-812, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 9-812. Publication of notices and ordinances; applicability

5 A. Notices of election, invitations for bids, notices of letting
6 contracts, laws and ordinances, and other notices of a public character
7 issued by authority of the governing body of any city or town, shall be
8 POSTED ON THE CITY'S OR TOWN'S WEBSITE AND published in one of the
9 following:

10 1. A newspaper that is printed and published within the city or
11 town.

12 2. A newspaper THAT IS printed and published within the county in
13 which the city or town is located with a greater circulation to residents
14 of the city or town.

15 B. In cases of laws or ordinances enacted on behalf of a private
16 person, ~~he~~ THE PRIVATE PERSON shall pay the expense of publication, and
17 may designate the newspaper.

18 C. Subsection A of this section ~~shall further apply~~ APPLIES to
19 notices and resolutions that require newspaper publication under title 48,
20 chapter 4 unless otherwise stated in title 48.
