AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 15-456, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO SCHOOL DISTRICT BOUNDARY PROVISIONS AND ELECTIONS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 15-456, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 15-456. Jurisdiction of county board of supervisors and
5 county school superintendent over joint common
6 school district

7 A. The county of jurisdiction of the proposed joint common school
8 district is that county in which the greater portion of the qualified
9 electors of the proposed joint common school district resides, unless all
10 of the existing school buildings located on territory ~~which~~ THAT will be
11 within the proposed joint common school district are in one county, in
12 which event that county shall be the county of jurisdiction.

13 B. The jurisdictional county of the joint common school district
14 shall exercise authority as provided for in this section and ~~sections~~
15 ~~15-429, 15-453 through 15-455, 15-457, 15-491, subsection B, 15-975 and~~
16 ~~15-997~~ AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED FOR THE JOINT COMMON SCHOOL DISTRICTS. The
17 county school superintendent of the jurisdictional county shall perform
18 for and in respect to the joint common school district all duties required
19 to be performed by county school superintendents. The board of
20 supervisors of the same county shall have jurisdiction over and perform
21 all duties for and with respect to the joint common school district as
22 required to be performed by boards of supervisors, except that school
23 district taxes to be levied on property in the portion of the joint common
24 school district lying in another county shall be levied by the board of
25 supervisors of such other county.
