AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 38, CHAPTER 8, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING ARTICLE
4; RELATING TO PUBLIC SAFETY.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 38, chapter 8, Arizona Revised Statutes, is
3 amended by adding article 4, to read:

4 ARTICLE 4. MISSING AND UNIDENTIFIED PERSON REPORTING

5 38-1181. Missing and unidentified person reports

6 A LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY THAT RECEIVES A REPORT OF A MISSING OR
7 UNIDENTIFIED PERSON SHALL SUBMIT THE REPORT OF THE MISSING AND
8 UNIDENTIFIED PERSON TO THE NATIONAL MISSING AND UNIDENTIFIED PERSON SYSTEM
9 THAT IS ADMINISTERED BY THE NATIONAL INSTITUTE OF JUSTICE IF THE CASE
10 REMAINS OPEN AND UNSOLVED FOR THIRTY DAYS AFTER RECEIVING THE INITIAL
11 REPORT.
