HOUSE BILL 2170

AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 16, CHAPTER 1, ARTICLE 3, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY
ADDING SECTION 16-143; RELATING TO REGISTRATION OFFICERS AND PROCEDURES.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 16, chapter 1, article 3, Arizona Revised
3 Statutes, is amended by adding section 16-143, to read:

4 16-143. Disclosure; third-party election mailings

5 A. ANY NONGOVERNMENTAL PERSON OR ENTITY THAT MAILS OR SENDS BY
6 EMAIL OR PROVIDES AN ELECTRONIC OR DIGITAL LINK TO AN OFFICIAL
7 ELECTION-RELATED DOCUMENT FROM THE COUNTY RECORDER OR COUNTY OFFICER IN
8 CHARGE OF ELECTIONS OR THE SECRETARY OF STATE, INCLUDING A VOTER
9 REGISTRATION APPLICATION OR AN EARLY BALLOT REQUEST, SHALL INCLUDE THE
10 WORDS "NOT FROM A GOVERNMENT AGENCY" IN BOLDFACED, CLEARLY LEGIBLE PRINT
11 ON THE OUTSIDE OF THE ENVELOPE OR PROMINENTLY PLACED IN THE ELECTRONIC OR
12 DIGITAL MESSAGE.

13 B. FOR AN ELECTRONIC OR DIGITAL DELIVERY, THE DISCLOSURE SHALL BE
14 CLEARLY READABLE. FOR A DELIVERY BY MAIL OR BY HAND, THE DISCLOSURE SHALL
15 BE DISPLAYED IN A HEIGHT THAT IS AT LEAST TEN PERCENT OF THE VERTICAL
16 HEIGHT OF THE DOCUMENT.
