1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 32-927, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 32-927. Violations; classification

5 A person is guilty of a class 6 felony who:

6 1. Practices chiropractic without a license.

7 2. Buys, sells or fraudulently obtains a diploma or license to
8 practice chiropractic.

9 3. Uses the title chiropractor, ~~OR~~ OR D.C., or any other word or
10 title to induce belief that he is engaged in the practice of chiropractic,
11 without a license to practice chiropractic.
