AMENDING SECTION 11-419, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO COUNTY OFFICERS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:
 2 Section 1. Section 11-419, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to

4 11-419. County salaries

5 A. In counties having a population of five hundred thousand or more
 6 persons, the following annual salaries shall be paid to county officers:

38 C. Each of the officers named in subsections A and B of this
 39 section, other than the board of supervisors and the county attorney, may
 40 appoint a chief deputy who shall receive an annual salary agreed on by the
 41 board of supervisors and the officer appointing the deputy.

42 D. The county attorney shall devote full time to the county
 43 attorney's official duties and shall not engage in the private practice of
 44 law. The county attorney shall appoint a chief deputy who shall receive

1 an annual salary agreed on by the board of supervisors and the officer
2 appointing the chief deputy.

3 E. In any county included under subsection B of this section, a
4 chief deputy county attorney shall not be appointed unless authorized by
5 the board of supervisors who may authorize or prohibit the chief deputy
6 from engaging in the private practice of law. The annual salary of the
7 chief deputy shall be in an amount agreed on by the county attorney and
8 the board of supervisors.

9 F. In case of a vacancy in office of any elected county officer
10 included in subsections A and B of this section, the salary of the person
11 appointed to fill such vacancy shall be the same for the balance of the
12 unexpired term as that being paid the previous officeholder.
