AMENDING SECTION 9-812, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO MUNICIPAL ORDINANCES.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:
2 Section 1. Section 9-812, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to

4 9-812. Publication and posting of notices and ordinances;
5 applicability
6 A. Notices of election, invitations for bids, notices of letting
7 contracts, laws and ordinances, ~~and~~ and other notices of a public character
8 issued by authority of the governing body of any city or town, ~~shall~~ shall be
9 published in one of the following:
10 1. A newspaper that is printed and published within the city or
11 town.
12 2. A newspaper THAT IS printed and published within the county in
13 which the city or town is located with a greater circulation to residents
14 of the city or town.
15 B. CITIES OR TOWNS LOCATED WITHIN A COUNTY WITH A POPULATION OF
16 FOUR MILLION PERSONS OR MORE SHALL HAVE THE OPTION TO POST THE NOTICE
17 REQUIRED PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION A OF THIS SECTION ON THE CITY'S OR TOWN'S
18 WEBSITE. A CITY OR TOWN THAT POSTS NOTICES ON THE CITY'S OR TOWN'S
19 WEBSITE SHALL PROVIDE ON THE WEBSITE'S HOME PAGE A LINK TO A LISTING OF
20 ALL CURRENT NOTICES AND ORDINANCES.
21 ~~B.~~ C. In cases of laws or ordinances enacted on behalf of a
22 private person, ~~the~~ THE PRIVATE PERSON shall pay the expense of
23 publication, ~~and~~ and may designate the newspaper.
24 ~~C.~~ D. ~~Subsection~~ SUBSECTIONS A AND B of this section ~~shall further~~
25 apply to notices and resolutions that require newspaper publication under
26 title 48, chapter 4 unless otherwise stated in title 48.
