AN ACT

AMENDING SECTIONS 32-511 AND 32-512.01, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO COSMETOLOGY.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 32-511, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to  
3 read:

4 32-511. Cosmetologists; applications; qualifications

5 A person is entitled to receive a cosmetologist license if the  
6 person does all of the following:

7 1. Submits to the board an application for a cosmetologist license  
8 on a form supplied by the board.

9 2. Does either of the following:

10 (a) Completes and receives appropriate credits for at least two  
11 years of high school education or its equivalent as prescribed by the  
12 board in its rules and submits satisfactory evidence that the person is at  
13 least sixteen years of age.

14 (b) Submits to the board satisfactory evidence that the person is  
15 at least eighteen years of age.

16 3. Submits to the board satisfactory evidence of any of the  
17 following:

18 (a) That the person is a graduate of a cosmetology course  
19 consisting of at least one thousand ~~five hundred~~ hours of training in a  
20 school licensed by the board.

21 (b) That the person is a graduate of a cosmetology school in  
22 another state or country that had at the time of the person's graduation  
23 substantially the same requirements as this state for schools licensed by  
24 the board.

25 (c) That the person completed a United States department of  
26 labor-approved or a department of economic security-approved  
27 apprenticeship program in cosmetology that includes at least two hundred  
28 fifty hours of infection protection and law review instruction. The  
29 person shall complete the instruction prescribed by this subdivision  
30 through either:

31 (i) A school that is licensed ~~pursuant to this chapter~~ **BY THE BOARD**  
32 or a school or program in another state that has, in the board's opinion,  
33 licensure requirements that are substantially equivalent to the  
34 requirements of this state.

35 (ii) A department of economic security-approved apprenticeship  
36 program.

37 4. Passes the examination for a cosmetologist license.

38 5. Pays the prescribed fees.

39 Sec. 2. Section 32-512.01, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to

41 32-512.01. Hairstylists; applications; qualifications

42 A person is entitled to receive a license to practice hairstyling if  
43 the person does all of the following:

44 1. Submits to the board an application for a hairstylist license on  
45 a form supplied by the board.

- 1           2. Either:
- 2           (a) Completes and receives appropriate credits for at least two
- 3 years of high school education or its equivalent as prescribed by the
- 4 board in its rules and submits satisfactory evidence that the person is at
- 5 least sixteen years of age.
- 6           (b) Submits to the board satisfactory evidence that the person is
- 7 at least eighteen years of age.
- 8           3. Submits to the board satisfactory evidence that the person
- 9 either:
- 10          (a) Graduated from a hairstyling school in another state or country
- 11 that had at the time of the person's graduation substantially the same
- 12 requirements as this state for schools licensed by the board.
- 13          (b) Completed a hairstylist course consisting of at least ~~one~~
- 14 ~~thousand~~ SIX HUNDRED hours of training in a school licensed by the board.
- 15           4. Pays the prescribed fees for a hairstylist license.
- 16           5. Passes the examination for a hairstylist license.
