AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 15-1341, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO THE
ARIZONA STATE SCHOOLS FOR THE DEAF AND BLIND.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 15-1341, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 15-1341. Instruction of pupils

5 A. The board of directors shall see that all persons admitted to
6 the school are taught and trained by methods ~~which~~ THAT are to their best
7 interests.

8 B. The board shall ensure the careful supervision of the care,
9 education and development of pupils to ~~insure~~ ENSURE that the best care
10 and education known to modern science ~~is~~ ARE given, as nearly as is
11 practicable, and that the best methods of teaching ~~the~~ INDIVIDUALS WITH
12 sensory ~~impaired~~ IMPAIRMENTS are used in the school.

13 C. The board shall give special attention to the methods of care,
14 education and development of the persons WHO ARE admitted, with particular
15 consideration of the humanitarian aspects of their education.

16 D. The board, if advisable in particular cases, may allow pupils to
17 remain at the school during the entire year.
