AMENDING TITLE 41, CHAPTER 41, ARTICLE 1, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY
ADDING SECTION 41-4259; APPROPRIATING MONIES; RELATING TO IMMIGRATION
ENFORCEMENT.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:
2 Section 1. Title 41, chapter 41, article 1, Arizona Revised
3 Statutes, is amended by adding section 41-4259, to read:

4 41-4259. Local immigration enforcement reimbursement fund

5 THE LOCAL IMMIGRATION ENFORCEMENT REIMBURSEMENT FUND IS ESTABLISHED
6 CONSISTING OF LEGISLATIVE APPROPRIATIONS AND PRIVATE DONATIONS. THE
7 DEPARTMENT SHALL ADMINISTER THE FUND. MONIES IN THE FUND ARE CONTINUOUSLY
8 APPROPRIATED AND ARE EXEMPT FROM THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 35-190 RELATING
9 TO LAPsing OF APPROPRIATIONS. MONIES IN THE FUND MAY BE USED TO REIMBURSE
10 A COUNTY OR LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY FOR COSTS INCURRED BY THE AGENCY
11 FOR PARTICIPATING IN A PROGRAM WITH THE UNITED STATES IMMIGRATION AND
12 CUSTOMS ENFORCEMENT PURSUANT TO 8 UNITED STATES CODE SECTION 1357(g).

13 Sec. 2. Appropriation; local immigration enforcement
14 reimbursement fund

15 The sum of \$30,000,000 is appropriated from the state general fund
16 in fiscal year 2022-2023 to the local immigration enforcement
17 reimbursement fund established by section 41-4259, Arizona Revised
18 Statutes, as added by this act.
