AND COMMERCIAL FRAUD.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 13-2204, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 13-2204. Defrauding secured creditors; classification;
5 definition

6 A. A person commits defrauding secured creditors if the person
7 knowingly destroys, removes, conceals, encumbers, converts, sells,
8 obtains, transfers, controls or otherwise deals with property subject to a
9 security interest with the intent to hinder or prevent the enforcement of
10 that interest.

11 ~~C.~~ B. Defrauding secured creditors is a class 6 felony.

12 ~~B.~~ C. For the purposes of this section, "control" has the same
13 meaning ~~as~~ prescribed by section 13-1801.
