**REPEALING TITLE 36, CHAPTER 6, ARTICLE 4.2, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES;
AMENDING TITLE 36, CHAPTER 6, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING A NEW
ARTICLE 4.2; RELATING TO PUBLIC HEALTH CONTROL.**

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:
2 Section 1. Repeal
3 Title 36, chapter 6, article 4.2, Arizona Revised Statutes, is
4 repealed.
5 Sec. 2. Title 36, chapter 6, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended
6 by adding a new article 4.2, to read:
7 ARTICLE 4.2. PUBLIC HEALTH MANDATES
8 36-681. Vaccinations; masks; enforcement prohibition;
9 violation; classification; definition
10 A. ANY GOVERNMENTAL ENTITY OR ANY PERSON DOING BUSINESS IN THIS
11 STATE MAY NOT ENFORCE ON A STUDENT WITHOUT PARENTAL CONSENT OR ON AN
12 EMPLOYEE ANY REQUIREMENT THAT THE PERSON RECEIVE A VACCINATION FOR
13 COVID-19 OR ANY VARIANT OF COVID-19 OR WEAR A MASK.
14 B. A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A CLASS 1
15 MISDEMEANOR.
16 C. THE COUNTY ATTORNEY MAY PROSECUTE ANY VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION.
17 D. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, "GOVERNMENTAL ENTITY" MEANS
18 THIS STATE AND ANY POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THIS STATE THAT RECEIVES AND
19 USES STATE TAX REVENUES.
20 Sec. 3. Short title
21 This act may be cited as the "Health Care Freedom Act".
