2 Section 1. Section 36-2903.04, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended

6 A. The administration shall determine the eligibility of any
7 eligible person as defined in section 36-2901, paragraph 6, subdivision
8 (a), item (iii) ~~and shall redetermine eligibility on an annual~~
~~basis.~~ SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE CENTERS FOR MEDICARE AND MEDICAID
9 SERVICES, THE ADMINISTRATION OR THE ADMINISTRATION'S DESIGNEE SHALL
10 ANNUALLY RENEW THE ELIGIBILITY OF A PERSON WHO IS DETERMINED ELIGIBLE
11 PURSUANT TO SECTION 36-2901, PARAGRAPH 6, SUBDIVISION (a), ITEM (iii)
12 WITHOUT REQUIRING ADDITIONAL INFORMATION FROM THE PERSON UNTIL THE PERSON
13 REACHES TWENTY-SIX YEARS OF AGE, UNLESS THE PERSON NOTIFIES THE
14 ADMINISTRATION THAT THE PERSON EITHER:

15 1. MOVED OUT OF THIS STATE.

16 2. PROVIDED INFORMATION TO THE ADMINISTRATION INDICATING THAT THE
17 PERSON MAY QUALIFY FOR A DIFFERENT ELIGIBILITY CATEGORY.

18 B. DURING THE PERSON'S ELIGIBILITY PERIOD, THE ADMINISTRATION OR
19 ITS DESIGNEE MAY USE RELIABLE INFORMATION AVAILABLE TO THE AGENCY TO
20 DETERMINE THE PERSON'S STATE RESIDENCY, INCLUDING THROUGH AN ELECTRONIC
21 DATA MATCH.
