AN ACT

AMENDING SECTIONS 41-1103 AND 41-1104, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO THE LEGISLATURE.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:
2 Section 1. Section 41-1103, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 41-1103. Compensation; reimbursement of expenditures

5 A. Members of the legislature are each entitled to receive ~~in THE~~ annual salary established pursuant to ~~the provisions of section 41-1904~~
6 ~~ARTICLE V, SECTION 12, CONSTITUTION OF ARIZONA.~~

7 B. In addition to the salary provided in subsection A of this
8 section, each member of the legislature shall also be reimbursed for
9 travel and subsistence expenses incurred in attendance ~~upon~~ ON regular
10 sessions or special sessions and for acting in a legislative matter, other
11 than in a regular or special session, ~~upon~~ ON prior approval of the
12 presiding officer of either house of the legislature at such rate and in
13 such manner as may be prescribed by law.

14 Sec. 2. Section 41-1104, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
15 read:

16 41-1104. Travel reimbursement and subsistence for members of
17 legislature: claim required

18 A. Notwithstanding section ~~38-624~~ 38-623, each member of the
19 legislature shall be reimbursed for travel at the federal mileage
20 reimbursement rate as determined annually by the United States general
21 services administration, and such reimbursement shall include travel from
22 the temporary or permanent residence of the member to the state capitol.

23 B. Each member of the legislature shall be paid for each day of
24 subsistence during a regular or special session and for each day of
25 subsistence when the member acts on a legislative matter, other than in a
26 regular or special session, on the prior approval of the presiding officer
27 of the house of which that member is a member in an amount as follows:

28 1. For a member whose permanent residence is within Maricopa
29 county, \$35, EXCEPT THAT THE MEMBER MAY NOT RECEIVE MORE THAN \$10,000 IN A
30 CALENDAR YEAR.

31 2. For a member whose permanent residence is outside Maricopa
32 county, one hundred percent of the average of the six highest months of
33 the annual federal per diem rate for Maricopa county, including lodging,
34 as determined by the United States general services administration, EXCEPT
35 THAT THE MEMBER MAY NOT RECEIVE MORE THAN \$40,000 IN A CALENDAR YEAR. The
36 director of the department of administration shall determine ~~this~~ THE PER
37 DIEM amount annually.

38 C. Subsistence allowed to each member of the legislature during the
39 ~~regular session as provided in subsection B of this section shall be~~
40 ~~limited to the first one hundred twenty days of a regular session. After~~
41 ~~the first one hundred twenty days of a regular session, each member of the~~
42 ~~legislature whose permanent residence is within Maricopa county shall be~~
43 ~~paid the sum of \$10 for subsistence for each day of the regular session~~
44 ~~beyond the first one hundred twenty days. Each member whose permanent~~

1 ~~residence is outside of Maricopa county shall receive fifty percent of the~~
2 ~~amount determined annually by the director of the department of~~
3 ~~administration pursuant to subsection B of this section for each day~~
4 ~~beyond the first one hundred twenty days of a regular session as~~
5 ~~subsistence.~~

6 ~~D.~~ C. Each member of the legislature may elect to opt out of
7 receiving subsistence payments prescribed by ~~subsections~~ SUBSECTION B ~~and~~
8 ~~E~~ of this section.

9 ~~E.~~ D. Each member of the legislature, for authorized travel out of
10 state, shall receive travel and subsistence expenses as prescribed by law
11 for state officers.

12 ~~F.~~ E. For payment of travel expenses and subsistence, as
13 prescribed by the terms of this section, each member of the legislature
14 shall submit a claim for travel expenses and subsistence that is
15 countersigned by the presiding officer of the respective body.

16 Sec. 3. Conditional enactment

17 This act does not become effective unless the Constitution of
18 Arizona is amended by a vote of the people at the next general election by
19 passage of House Concurrent Resolution ___, fifty-fifth legislature,
20 second regular session.
