AN ACT

APPROPRIATING MONIES TO THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE ON TRIBAL RELATIONS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Appropriations; governor's office on tribal  
3 relations; remedial education; San Carlos Apache  
4 college; report; fiscal years 2022-2023,  
5 2023-2024 and 2024-2025

6 A. The sum of \$3,000,000 is appropriated from the state general  
7 fund in each of fiscal years 2022-2023, 2023-2024 and 2024-2025 to the  
8 governor's office on tribal relations established by section 41-2051,  
9 Arizona Revised Statutes, for distribution to the San Carlos Apache  
10 college for the remedial education of students who:

- 11 1. Graduated from a public high school located in this state.
- 12 2. Are enrolled in classes conducted at a San Carlos Apache college  
13 campus located in this state.

14 B. Before distributing the appropriation made in subsection A of  
15 this section, the governor's office on tribal relations must enter into an  
16 agreement with the San Carlos Apache college specifying that the college  
17 will report and analyze the course completion rate for students who  
18 received the remedial education during the 2022-2023, 2023-2024 and  
19 2024-2025 academic years. The San Carlos Apache college shall submit the  
20 report not later than ninety days after the conclusion of each of the  
21 academic years to the governor, the president of the senate, the speaker  
22 of the house of representatives and the secretary of state.
