A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE CONSTITUTION OF ARIZONA; REPEALING ARTICLE
XXX, CONSTITUTION OF ARIZONA; RELATING TO MARRIAGE.

1 Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of Arizona,
2 the Senate concurring:
3 1. Article XXX, Constitution of Arizona, is proposed to be repealed
4 as follows if approved by the voters and on proclamation of the Governor:
5 Article XXX, Constitution of Arizona, relating to
6 marriage as only a union of one man and one woman, is
7 repealed.
8 2. The Secretary of State shall submit this proposition to the
9 voters at the next general election as provided by article XXI,
10 Constitution of Arizona.
