A RESOLUTION

SUPPORTING THE CONSTRUCTION AND OPERATION OF A FISHER HOUSE IN PHOENIX TO SERVE SERVICE MEMBERS, VETERANS AND THEIR FAMILIES.

1 Whereas, for the dedicated men and women who serve in our nation's
2 armed forces, the cost of battle continues long after the last round is
3 fired; and

4 Whereas, veterans continue to bear the burden of the wars they
5 fought and the wounds they carry; and

6 Whereas, the sacred responsibility for caring for these valiant
7 warriors falls to the veterans' families, their communities and their
8 leaders; and

9 Whereas, our wounded, injured and ill service members and their
10 families need a home away from home; and

11 Whereas, the Fisher House Foundation builds comfort homes where
12 service members and veterans and their families can stay free of charge
13 while a loved one is in the hospital.

14 Therefore

15 Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of Arizona:

16 That the Members of the House of Representatives support the
17 construction and operation of a Fisher House near the Veterans Affairs
18 Medical Center in Phoenix.
