AMENDING TITLE 36, CHAPTER 21.1, ARTICLE 1, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY
ADDING SECTION 36-2224.01; RELATING TO EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 36, chapter 21.1, article 1, Arizona Revised
3 Statutes, is amended by adding section 36-2224.01, to read:

4 36-2224.01. Rural areas; emergency medical situations;
5 patient transportation

6 NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER LAW, IN RURAL AREAS OF A COUNTY WITH A
7 POPULATION OF LESS THAN FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND PERSONS, A FIRE DEPARTMENT
8 OR FIRE DISTRICT MAY PROVIDE AMBULANCE SERVICE TO TRANSPORT A PATIENT IN
9 AN EMERGENCY MEDICAL SITUATION REGARDLESS OF WHETHER THE FIRE DEPARTMENT
10 OR FIRE DISTRICT HAS A CERTIFICATE OF NECESSITY ISSUED PURSUANT TO ARTICLE
11 2 OF THIS CHAPTER FOR THE AREA.
