AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 16, CHAPTER 4, ARTICLE 1, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY
ADDING SECTION 16-410.01; RELATING TO THE CONDUCT OF ELECTIONS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 16, chapter 4, article 1, Arizona Revised
3 Statutes, is amended by adding section 16-410.01, to read:

4 16-410.01. Election contractors; liability for damages;
5 violation; classification

6 A. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER LAW, A CONTRACTOR THAT ENTERS INTO A
7 CONTRACT WITH THIS STATE OR ANY COUNTY TO PROVIDE ELECTION-RELATED
8 EQUIPMENT OR SERVICES AND THAT FAILS TO PERFORM ITS OBLIGATIONS UNDER THE
9 TERMS OF THE CONTRACT IS LIABLE FOR LIQUIDATED DAMAGES IN AN AMOUNT
10 EQUIVALENT TO THE AMOUNT PAID UNDER THE TERMS OF THE CONTRACT.

11 B. A CONTRACTOR THAT FAILS TO PERFORM ITS OBLIGATIONS AS PRESCRIBED
12 BY SUBSECTION A OF THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A CLASS 2 MISDEMEANOR.
