# SENATE BILL 1174

AN ACT

AMENDING LAWS 2021, CHAPTER 406, SECTION 33; RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF  
TRANSPORTATION.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Laws 2021, chapter 406, section 33 is amended to read:

4 highway construction; fiscal year 2020-2021;  
5 exemption; lapsing

1           B. Notwithstanding section 41-1252, Arizona Revised Statutes, the  
2 appropriations made in subsection A of this section are not subject to  
3 review by the joint committee on capital review.

4           C. The appropriations made in subsection A of this section do not  
5 lapse until the purpose for which the appropriations were made has been  
6 accomplished or abandoned, or the appropriations stand for a full fiscal  
7 year without an expenditure or encumbrance.
