# SENATE BILL 1359

AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 16, CHAPTER 4, ARTICLE 1, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY  
ADDING SECTION 16-407.04; RELATING TO THE CONDUCT OF ELECTIONS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 16, chapter 4, article 1, Arizona Revised  
3 Statutes, is amended by adding section 16-407.04, to read:

4 16-407.04. Election systems and activities; unique password  
5 required; violation; classification

6 A. FOR ANY ELECTION SYSTEM OR ACTIVITY THAT REQUIRES AN EMPLOYEE,  
7 CONTRACTOR OR VOLUNTEER TO LOG IN TO THE SYSTEM, EACH EMPLOYEE, CONTRACTOR  
8 OR VOLUNTEER SHALL HAVE A UNIQUE PASSWORD THAT MAY NOT BE DISCLOSED TO ANY  
9 OTHER PERSON. EXCEPT FOR THE 30 DAYS BEFORE AN ELECTION, EACH EMPLOYEE,  
10 CONTRACTOR OR VOLUNTEER SHALL ESTABLISH A NEW UNIQUE PASSWORD EVERY TWO  
11 WEEKS. THIS SUBSECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO POLLWORKERS USING AN ELECTRONIC  
12 POLLBOOK TO CHECK-IN VOTERS.

13 B. A PERSON WHO KNOWINGLY VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A  
14 CLASS 2 MISDEMEANOR.
