### **AN ACT**

REPEALING SECTION 41-3022.15, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; AMENDING TITLE 41, CHAPTER 27, ARTICLE 2, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 41-3030.15; RELATING TO THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:  
2 Section 1. Repeal  
3 Section 41-3022.15, Arizona Revised Statutes, is repealed.  
4 Sec. 2. Title 41, chapter 27, article 2, Arizona Revised Statutes,  
5 is amended by adding section 41-3030.15, to read:  
6 41-3030.15. State department of corrections; termination  
7 July 1, 2030  
8 A. THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS TERMINATES ON JULY 1, 2030.  
9 B. TITLE 41, CHAPTER 11 AND THIS SECTION ARE REPEALED ON JANUARY 1,  
10 2031.  
11 Sec. 3. Purpose  
12 Pursuant to section 41-2955, subsection B, Arizona Revised Statutes,  
13 the legislature continues the state department of corrections to encompass  
14 the correctional programs of this state and to provide supervisory staff  
15 and administrative functions at the state level for all matters relating  
16 to the institutionalization, rehabilitation, parole and community  
17 supervision functions of all adult offenders.  
18 Sec. 4. Retroactivity  
19 Sections 1 and 2 of this act apply retroactively to from and after  
20 July 1, 2022.
