AN ACT

REPEALING TITLE 36, CHAPTER 6, ARTICLE 4.2, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES;  
AMENDING TITLE 36, CHAPTER 6, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING A NEW  
ARTICLE 4.2; RELATING TO PUBLIC HEALTH CONTROL.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Repeal

3 Title 36, chapter 6, article 4.2, Arizona Revised Statutes, is  
4 repealed.

5 Sec. 2. Title 36, chapter 6, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended  
6 by adding a new article 4.2, to read:

7 ARTICLE 4.2. PUBLIC HEALTH MANDATES

8 36-681. COVID-19 vaccine; employer prohibition; definition

9 A. ANY GOVERNMENT ENTITY OR ANY PERSON DOING BUSINESS IN THIS STATE  
10 MAY NOT REQUIRE AN EMPLOYEE TO RECEIVE A VACCINATION FOR COVID-19 OR ANY  
11 VARIANT OF COVID-19.

12 B. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, "GOVERNMENT ENTITY" MEANS THIS  
13 STATE AND ANY POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THIS STATE THAT RECEIVES AND USES  
14 TAX REVENUES.
