AMENDING TITLE 36, CHAPTER 29, ARTICLE 1, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY
ADDING SECTION 36-2907.03; RELATING TO THE ARIZONA HEALTH CARE COST
CONTAINMENT SYSTEM.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 36, chapter 29, article 1, Arizona Revised
3 Statutes, is amended by adding section 36-2907.03, to read:

4 36-2907.03. DNA-matched drug testing; requirements; annual
5 report

6 A. IN ANY SUBSTANCE USE DISORDER TREATMENT PROVIDED PURSUANT TO
7 THIS ARTICLE, THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL REQUIRE CONTRACTORS TO IMPLEMENT
8 RANDOM DNA-MATCHED DRUG TESTING FOR A MEMBER WHO HAS GRADUATED FROM AN
9 TREATMENT PROGRAM FUNDED BY THE ADMINISTRATION, UNLESS THE MEMBER IS ON
10 PROBATION OR PAROLE. THE DRUG TESTING MUST OCCUR AT LEAST TWO TIMES EACH
11 MONTH FOR SIX MONTHS IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING GRADUATION FROM THE TREATMENT
12 PROGRAM AND INCLUDE TESTING FOR PSYCHOTROPIC MEDICATIONS.

13 B. ON OR BEFORE OCTOBER 1, 2023 AND ON OR BEFORE OCTOBER 1 OF EACH
14 YEAR THEREAFTER, THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL SUBMIT A REPORT TO THE GOVERNOR,
15 THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE, THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
16 AND THE CHAIRPERSONS OF THE HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES COMMITTEES IN THE
17 SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, OR THEIR SUCCESSOR COMMITTEES,
18 AND SHALL PROVIDE A COPY OF THE REPORT TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE. THE
19 REPORT SHALL INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION FOR THE PRECEDING YEAR
20 RELATING TO SUBSTANCE USE DISORDER TREATMENT PROGRAMS FUNDED BY THE
21 ADMINISTRATION:

22 1. THE TOTAL NUMBER OF GRADUATED MEMBERS AND THE MEMBERS'
23 EMPLOYMENT STATUS, INDICATING FULL-TIME OR PART-TIME EMPLOYMENT.

24 2. THE PERCENTAGE OF GRADUATED MEMBERS WHO RELAPSED WITHIN THE
25 SIX-MONTH TRACKING PERIOD THAT IS VERIFIED BY THE REQUIRED DNA-MATCHED
26 DRUG TESTING.

27 3. THE NUMBER OF GRADUATED MEMBERS WHO ARE THE SUBJECT OF THE
28 DEPARTMENT OF CHILD SERVICES OVERSIGHT, INCLUDING THE NUMBER OF THOSE
29 MEMBERS WHO ARE PARENTS WHO ARE ENGAGED IN REUNIFICATION OR HAVE BEEN
30 REUNIFIED WITH THEIR CHILDREN.

31 4. THE NUMBER OF GRADUATED MEMBERS WHO RETURNED TO AN
32 ADMINISTRATION-FUNDED DRUG TREATMENT PROGRAM WITHIN SIX MONTHS AFTER
33 GRADUATION.

34 5. THE NUMBER OF GRADUATED MEMBERS WHO ARE ENROLLED IN SCHOOL FULL
35 TIME OR PART TIME.

36 6. THE NUMBER OF GRADUATED MEMBERS WHO ARE ENROLLED IN JOB SKILLS
37 TRAINING.

38 7. THE NUMBER OF GRADUATED MEMBERS WHO ARE HOUSED AND WHO HAVE
39 THEIR OWN LEASE OR MORTGAGE.

40 8. THE NUMBER OF GRADUATED MEMBERS WHO LIVE WITH A FRIEND OR FAMILY
41 MEMBER.

42 9. THE NUMBER OF GRADUATED MEMBERS WHO IDENTIFY AS HOMELESS.
