# **SB 1555**

## AN ACT

REPEALING SECTION 23-362, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, AS AMENDED BY LAWS 1997, CHAPTER 51, SECTION 1; AMENDING SECTION 23-363, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO EMPLOYMENT PRACTICES.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2       Section 1. Repeal

3       Subject to the requirements of article IV, part 1, section 1,  
4 Constitution of Arizona, section 23-362, Arizona Revised Statutes, as  
5 amended by Laws 1997, chapter 51, section 1, is repealed.

6       Sec. 2. Subject to the requirements of article IV, part 1,  
7 section 1, Constitution of Arizona, section 23-363, Arizona Revised  
8 Statutes, is amended to read:

9       23-363. Minimum wage

10      A. Employers shall pay employees ~~to~~ NOT less than the minimum wage,  
11 which shall be not less than:

12      1. ~~\$10 on and after January 1, 2017.~~

13      2. ~~\$10.50 on and after January 1, 2018.~~

14      3. ~~\$11 on and after January 1, 2019.~~

15      4. ~~\$12 on and after January 1, 2020 \$20 PER HOUR ON AND AFTER THE  
16 EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS AMENDMENT TO THIS SECTION.~~

17      B. The minimum wage shall be increased on January 1, ~~2021~~ 2023 and  
18 on January 1 of successive years, by the increase in the cost of living.  
19 The increase in the cost of living shall be measured by the percentage  
20 increase as of August of the immediately preceding year over the level as  
21 of August of the previous year of the consumer price index (all urban  
22 consumers, ~~U.S.~~ UNITED STATES city average for all items) or its successor  
23 index as published by the ~~U.S.~~ UNITED STATES department of labor or its  
24 successor agency, with the amount of the minimum wage increase rounded to  
25 the nearest multiple of ~~five cents~~ \$.05.

26      C. For any employee who customarily and regularly receives tips or  
27 gratuities from patrons or others, the employer may pay a wage up to \$3.00  
28 per hour less than the minimum wage if the employer can establish by ~~its~~  
29 THE EMPLOYER'S records of charged tips or by the employee's declaration  
30 for federal insurance contributions act (FICA) purposes that for each  
31 week, when adding tips received to wages paid, the employee received not  
32 less than the minimum wage for all hours worked. Compliance with this  
33 provision SUBSECTION will be determined by averaging tips received by the  
34 employee over the course of the employer's payroll period or any other  
35 period selected by the employer that complies with regulations adopted by  
36 the commission.

37      Sec. 3. Requirements for enactment; three-fourths vote

38      Pursuant to article IV, part 1, section 1, Constitution of Arizona,  
39 section 23-362, Arizona Revised Statutes, as amended by Laws 1997, chapter  
40 51, section 1 and repealed by this act, and section 23-363, Arizona  
41 Revised Statutes, as amended by this act, are effective only on the  
42 affirmative vote of at least three-fourths of the members of each house of  
43 the legislature.
