# **SB 1606**

AN ACT

REPEALING SECTION 41-1365, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, AS AMENDED BY LAWS 2021, CHAPTER 405, SECTION 28; AMENDING SECTION 41-1365, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, AS AMENDED BY LAWS 2018, CHAPTER 279, SECTION 37; RELATING TO THE LEGISLATIVE GOVERNMENTAL MALL.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2       Section 1. Repeal

3       Section 41-1365, Arizona Revised Statutes, as amended by Laws 2021,  
4 chapter 405, section 28, is repealed.

5       Sec. 2. Section 41-1365, Arizona Revised Statutes, as amended by  
6 Laws 2018, chapter 279, section 37, is amended to read:

7       41-1365. State monument and memorial repair fund; purpose;  
8                   annual report; exemption

9       A. The state monument and memorial repair fund is established  
10 consisting of:

11       1. Donations.

12       2. Monies from ~~fund-raising~~ FUNDRAISING activities.

13       3. Monies that are collected by the proponents of a monument or  
14 memorial and that are deposited pursuant to section 41-1363.

15       4. Grants received for monuments or memorials, except for otherwise  
16 specifically dedicated grants.

17       5. Legislative appropriations.

18       B. The department of administration shall administer the fund. All  
19 monies in the fund are subject to legislative appropriation. Subject to  
20 this section, the department shall use monies appropriated from the fund  
21 ~~for~~ TO:

22       1. ~~The maintenance~~ ALTER, MODIFY, MAINTAIN, repair, ~~reconditioning~~  
23 RECONDITION or ~~relocation of~~ RELOCATE monuments or memorials. ~~and for~~  
24       2. ~~Supporting~~ SUPPORT mechanical equipment in the governmental  
25 mall.

26       C. The department OF ADMINISTRATION shall separately account for  
27 monies to a specific monument or memorial that is dedicated to this state  
28 for ~~maintenance, repair~~ MAINTAINING, REPAIRING, reconditioning or  
29 ~~relocation of~~ RELOCATING that monument or memorial as follows:

30       1. Monies that are donated for the benefit of the specific monument  
31 or memorial.

32       2. Monies that are derived from ~~fund-raising~~ FUNDRAISING activities  
33 and that are collected for the benefit of a specific monument or memorial.

34       3. Monies that are collected and deposited pursuant to subsection  
35 A, paragraph 3 of this section.

36       D. On or before November 1 of each year, the department of  
37 administration shall submit to the joint legislative budget committee a  
38 report that accounts for all monies deposited in the fund. The report  
39 shall include the sources of the monies received for deposit, by category,  
40 and the purposes for which the monies were used during the preceding  
41 fiscal year.

42       E. The department of administration shall hold the monies in the  
43 fund in trust for the citizens of this state until spent on an authorized  
44 monument or memorial, and monies in the fund shall not be spent or  
45 appropriated for any other purpose.

46       F. Monies in the fund are exempt from the provisions of section  
47 35-190 relating to lapsing of appropriations.
