AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF LOCAL REVENUES BY SCHOOL DISTRICTS IN EXCESS OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL EXPENDITURE LIMITATION IN FISCAL YEAR 2021-2022.

1 Be it resolved by the Senate of the State of Arizona, the House of
2 Representatives concurring:

3 1. That the legislature authorizes the expenditure of local
4 revenues by school districts in excess of the expenditure limitation
5 prescribed pursuant to article IX, section 21, Constitution of Arizona, in
6 fiscal year 2021-2022.

7 2. That the authorization provided by paragraph 1 is effective only
8 on the approval of this resolution by at least two-thirds of the
9 membership of each house of the legislature by roll call vote on or before
10 March 1, 2022.
