

PROPOSED

HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AMENDMENTS TO S.B. 1519

(Reference to Senate engrossed bill)

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert:

2 "Section 1. Arizona integrated student support grant pilot
3 program; requirements; grants; delayed repeal

4 A. A three-year Arizona integrated student support grant pilot
5 program is established in the department of education to assist public
6 elementary and middle schools in developing and implementing integrated
7 student support plans and participating in the pilot program. The
8 department of education shall select six schools with an enrollment of at
9 least four hundred pupils each, at least one of which is an elementary
10 school, to participate in the pilot program.

11 B. From monies appropriated for the pilot program, the department of
12 education shall award three-year grants to eligible schools. A school may
13 use monies received under this section in coordination with community-based
14 organizations for purposes including any of the following:

- 15 1. Early childhood education.
- 16 2. Academic support, interventions and tutoring services.
- 17 3. After-school and summer school academic and enrichment programs.
- 18 4. College and career preparation and advising.
- 19 5. Family engagement, including parental involvement, parent
20 leadership and family literacy.
- 21 6. Mentoring and youth development programs.
- 22 7. Programs to address chronic absenteeism.
- 23 8. Integrating systems from the department of education, department
24 of health services and department of economic security to maximize
25 resources offered to students and families to improve educational outcomes.

1 C. To be eligible for a grant under this section, a public
2 elementary or middle school shall demonstrate a commitment to both:

3 1. Participating in the pilot program by establishing both:

4 (a) An integrated student support plan partnership team to function
5 as the campus-level planning and decision-making committee that is composed
6 of school officials and community representatives.

7 (b) A partnership with a community-based organization, a state
8 agency or an education or youth services organization that has experience
9 in developing and implementing integrated student support plans.

10 2. Developing and implementing a plan for sustaining the integrated
11 student support plan beyond the end of the pilot program.

12 D. Grants awarded under this section may not be used for direct
13 programs for students or families or for other activities that are not
14 related to developing or implementing an integrated student support plan.

15 E. Each school that participates in the pilot program shall hire a
16 new employee or designate an existing employee to serve as the full-time
17 integrated student support plan coordinator for that school.

18 F. Before an integrated student support plan may be implemented, the
19 plan and the application to participate in the pilot program must be
20 approved by the school district governing board or the charter school
21 governing body.

22 G. In developing or implementing the integrated student support
23 plan, a school that participates in the pilot program may seek assistance
24 from other integrated system schools, regional education service centers or
25 technical assistance providers.

26 H. A school that is selected to participate in the pilot program
27 shall both:

28 1. Hold a community meeting at least twice each year to both:

29 (a) Inform community stakeholders about the school's progress in
30 implementing the plan.

31 (b) Seek community and parent input regarding any improvements or
32 changes that could be made to the plan.

1 2. Annually report to the school district governing board or the
2 charter school governing body regarding the school's progress in
3 implementing the plan.

4 I. The department of education shall disburse the monies
5 appropriated for the pilot program. The schools that are selected to
6 participate in the pilot program may seek additional funding through
7 public-private partnerships and may seek and accept gifts, grants,
8 donations and monies from federal, state and private sources for purposes
9 related to the pilot program.

10 J. This section is repealed from and after December 31, 2025.
