SENATE AMENDMENTS TO S.B. 1147

(Reference to printed bill)

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert:

2 "Section 1. Section 3-3614, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 3-3614. Applicator certification; categories; criminal records
5 check requirement

6 A. An application for applicator certification shall be in a form
7 prescribed by the director and be accompanied by the prescribed fee.

8 B. An individual may apply for certification as an applicator or
9 qualified applicator in any one or a combination of the following
10 categories:

11 1. Industrial, institutional, structural and health-related pest
12 management.

13 2. Wood-destroying organism management.

14 3. Ornamental and turf pest management.

15 4. Right-of-way pest management.

16 5. Aquatic pest management.

17 6. Fumigation.

18 7. Other categories or subcategories established by rule.

19 C. An individual who applies for certification as a new applicator
20 or a new qualified applicator shall submit to the division a full set of
21 fingerprints and fees as required by section 41-1750. The director shall
22 submit the fingerprints and fees to the department of public safety for the
23 purpose of obtaining a state and federal criminal records check pursuant to
24 section 41-1750 and Public Law 92-544. The department of public safety may
25 exchange this fingerprint data with the federal bureau of investigation.

1 D. AN INDIVIDUAL WHO APPLIES FOR CERTIFICATION AS A NEW APPLICATOR
2 OR A NEW QUALIFIED APPLICATOR MAY MEET THE REQUIREMENT PRESCRIBED IN
3 SUBSECTION C OF THIS SECTION BY SUBMITTING A CURRENT, UNEXPIRED FINGERPRINT
4 CLEARANCE CARD ISSUED PURSUANT TO SECTION 41-1758.03 OR A CURRENT,
5 UNEXPIRED LEVEL I FINGERPRINT CLEARANCE CARD ISSUED PURSUANT TO SECTION
6 41-1758.07 TO THE DEPARTMENT AS PART OF THE INDIVIDUAL'S APPLICATION.

7 Sec. 2. Applicator certification; approval time period;
8 delayed repeal

9 A. Notwithstanding any other law, the time period in which the pest
10 management division shall approve or deny an application for certification
11 as a new applicator pursuant to section 3-3614, Arizona Revised Statutes,
12 as amended by this act, is within one hundred twenty days after the
13 application is received.

14 B. This section is repealed from and after June 30, 2023.

15 Sec. 3. Emergency

16 This act is an emergency measure that is necessary to preserve the
17 public peace, health or safety and is operative immediately as provided by
18 law."
