AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 15-1808, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO POSTSECONDARY INSTITUTIONS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:
2 Section 1. Section 15-1808, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 15-1808. Tuition waiver scholarships; eligibility;
5 definitions

6 A. The Arizona board of regents, after verification by the Arizona
7 peace officers memorial board, by the Arizona fallen firefighter memorial
8 committee, by the adjutant general of the national guard or by the Arizona
9 department of veterans' services that a person is a child or the spouse of
10 a peace officer, correctional officer, firefighter, emergency paramedic,
11 national guard member or member of the United States armed forces who was
12 a resident of the state of Arizona or stationed in Arizona and who was
13 killed in the line of duty or who died from injuries suffered in the line
14 of duty while traveling to or from duty, shall provide the person who
15 qualifies under subsection ~~B~~ D of this section and who otherwise meets
16 the qualifications for admission with a tuition waiver scholarship at any
17 university under the jurisdiction of the Arizona board of regents. A
18 district as defined in section 15-1401, after verification by the Arizona
19 peace officers memorial board, by the Arizona fallen firefighter memorial
20 committee, by the adjutant general of the national guard or by the Arizona
21 department of veterans' services that a person is the child or the spouse
22 of a peace officer, correctional officer, firefighter, emergency
23 paramedic, national guard member or member of the United States armed
24 forces who was a resident of Arizona or stationed in Arizona and who was
25 killed in the line of duty or who died from injuries suffered in the line
26 of duty while traveling to or from duty, shall provide the person who
27 qualifies under subsection ~~B~~ D of this section and who otherwise meets
28 the qualifications for admission with a tuition waiver scholarship at any
29 community college under the jurisdiction of the district.

30 B. THE ARIZONA BOARD OF REGENTS, AFTER VERIFICATION BY THE ARIZONA
31 PEACE OFFICERS MEMORIAL BOARD, THE ARIZONA FALLEN FIREFIGHTER MEMORIAL
32 COMMITTEE OR THE DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS' SERVICES THAT A PERSON IS A CHILD
33 OR THE SPOUSE OF A PERSON WHO MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS PRESCRIBED IN
34 SUBSECTION C OF THIS SECTION, SHALL PROVIDE THE PERSON WHO QUALIFIES UNDER
35 SUBSECTION D OF THIS SECTION AND WHO OTHERWISE MEETS THE QUALIFICATIONS
36 FOR ADMISSION WITH A TUITION WAIVER SCHOLARSHIP AT ANY UNIVERSITY UNDER
37 THE JURISDICTION OF THE ARIZONA BOARD OF REGENTS. A DISTRICT AS DEFINED
38 IN SECTION 15-1401, AFTER VERIFICATION BY THE ARIZONA PEACE OFFICERS
39 MEMORIAL BOARD, THE ARIZONA FALLEN FIREFIGHTER MEMORIAL COMMITTEE OR THE
40 DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS' SERVICES THAT A PERSON IS A CHILD OR THE SPOUSE OF
41 A PERSON WHO MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS PRESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION C OF THIS
42 SECTION, SHALL PROVIDE THE PERSON WHO QUALIFIES UNDER SUBSECTION D OF THIS
43 SECTION AND WHO OTHERWISE MEETS THE QUALIFICATIONS FOR ADMISSION WITH A
44 TUITION WAIVER SCHOLARSHIP AT ANY COMMUNITY COLLEGE UNDER THE JURISDICTION
45 OF THE DISTRICT. NOTWITHSTANDING SECTION 15-1809, IF SUFFICIENT MONIES

1 ARE AVAILABLE, THE ARIZONA BOARD OF REGENTS SHALL DISTRIBUTE SURPLUS
2 MONIES THAT WERE APPROPRIATED TO THE SPOUSES OF MILITARY VETERANS TUITION
3 SCHOLARSHIP FUND ESTABLISHED BY SECTION 15-1809 TO EACH UNIVERSITY UNDER
4 THE JURISDICTION OF THE ARIZONA BOARD OF REGENTS FOR THE COSTS ASSOCIATED
5 WITH THE TUITION WAIVER SCHOLARSHIPS PROVIDED PURSUANT TO THIS SUBSECTION.

6 C. TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR A TUITION WAIVER SCHOLARSHIP UNDER SUBSECTION
7 B OF THIS SECTION, THE APPLICANT MUST BE THE CHILD OR SPOUSE OF A PERSON
8 WHO MEETS ALL OF THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA:

9 1. WAS A VETERAN OF THE UNITED STATES ARMED FORCES OR WAS SERVING
10 OR PREVIOUSLY SERVED AS A PEACE OFFICER, A FIREFIGHTER OR A MEMBER OF THE
11 UNITED STATES ARMED FORCES AT THE TIME OF THE PERSON'S DEATH. IT IS NOT A
12 REQUIREMENT FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS PARAGRAPH THAT THE PERSON WAS
13 EMPLOYED AS A PEACE OFFICER OR FIREFIGHTER OR WAS SERVING ON ACTIVE DUTY
14 AS A MEMBER OF THE UNITED STATES ARMED FORCES AT THE TIME OF THE PERSON'S
15 DEATH.

16 2. WAS A RESIDENT OF THIS STATE AT THE TIME OF THE PERSON'S DEATH.

17 3. SUFFERED A POSTTRAUMATIC STRESS INJURY IN THE LINE OF DUTY.
18 DOCUMENTATION THAT THE PEACE OFFICER OR FIREFIGHTER AT ANY POINT RECEIVED
19 A DISABILITY PENSION UNDER SECTION 38-844 FOR A POSTTRAUMATIC STRESS
20 INJURY OR BENEFITS UNDER TITLE 38, CHAPTER 5, ARTICLE 4.2 FOR A
21 POSTTRAUMATIC STRESS INJURY IS PRIMA FACIE EVIDENCE THAT THE PEACE OFFICER
22 OR FIREFIGHTER MET THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS PARAGRAPH. A DISCHARGE OR
23 OTHER DOCUMENT FROM THE UNITED STATES ARMED FORCES SHOWING THAT THE MEMBER
24 OR VETERAN OF THE UNITED STATES ARMED FORCES WAS DISCHARGED BECAUSE OF OR
25 SUFFERED FROM A POSTTRAUMATIC STRESS INJURY, OR DOCUMENTATION FROM THE
26 UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS SHOWING THAT THE MEMBER OR
27 VETERAN SUFFERED FROM A POSTTRAUMATIC STRESS INJURY, IS PRIMA FACIE
28 EVIDENCE THAT THE MEMBER OR VETERAN MET THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS
29 PARAGRAPH.

30 4. DIED BY SUICIDE.

31 ~~B.~~ D. The tuition waiver scholarships shall be limited to children
32 who are thirty years of age or younger or a spouse who has not remarried
33 and shall be limited for a spouse or for any one child to not more than
34 sixty-four credit hours at Arizona community colleges and a total number
35 of credits including any transfer credits from an Arizona community
36 college equal to the number of credits required for a baccalaureate degree
37 at Arizona universities for that student's initially declared course of
38 study.

39 ~~C.~~ E. A member of the Arizona national guard who received a purple
40 heart citation on or after September 11, 2001 or a former member of the
41 Arizona national guard who was medically discharged from the Arizona
42 national guard due to an injury or disability suffered during status under
43 title 10, United States Code, in weekend training status, in annual
44 training status or in response to a state of emergency declared by the

1 governor is eligible for a tuition waiver scholarship provided for in this
2 section.

3 ~~D.~~ F. The Arizona board of regents, after verification by the
4 Arizona department of veterans' services that a person is a member or
5 former member of the United States armed forces who received a purple
6 heart citation, who was a resident of the state of Arizona or was
7 stationed in Arizona at the time of the injury that resulted in the purple
8 heart citation and whose disability rating determined by the United States
9 department of veterans affairs is fifty percent or more, shall provide the
10 person who otherwise meets the qualifications for admission with a tuition
11 waiver scholarship at any university under the jurisdiction of the board.
12 A district as defined in section 15-1401, after verification by the
13 Arizona department of veterans' services that a person is a member or
14 former member of the United States armed forces who received a purple
15 heart citation, who was a resident of the state of Arizona or was
16 stationed in Arizona at the time of the injury that resulted in the purple
17 heart citation and whose disability rating determined by the United States
18 department of veterans affairs is fifty percent or more, shall provide the
19 person who otherwise meets the qualifications for admission with a tuition
20 waiver scholarship at any community college under the jurisdiction of the
21 district. A person who is convicted of a class 1, 2, 3, 4 or 5 felony is
22 ineligible for a tuition waiver scholarship AS provided ~~for~~ in this
23 subsection.

24 ~~E.~~ G. For the purposes of this section:

25 1. "Correctional officer" means a person, other than an elected
26 official, who is employed by this state or a county, city or town and who
27 is responsible for the supervision, protection, care, custody or control
28 of inmates in a state, county or municipal correctional institution,
29 including counselors but excluding secretarial, clerical and
30 professionally trained personnel.

31 2. "Emergency paramedic" means a person who has been trained in an
32 emergency paramedic training program certified by the director of the
33 department of health services or in an equivalent training program and who
34 is certified by the director of the department of health services to
35 render services pursuant to section 36-2205.

36 3. "Firefighter" means a professional firefighter who is a member
37 of a state, federal, tribal, city, county, district or private fire
38 department.

39 4. "Peace officers OFFICER" means ~~sheriffs of counties~~ A COUNTY
40 SHERIFF, ~~constables~~ A CONSTABLE, ~~marshals~~ A MARSHAL, A police ~~officers of~~
41 ~~cities and towns~~ OFFICER OF A CITY OR TOWN, AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS
42 commissioned ~~personnel of~~ BY the department of public safety and A police
43 ~~officers~~ OFFICER WHO IS appointed by A community college district
44 governing ~~boards~~ BOARD or the Arizona board of regents who ~~have~~ received a
45 certificate from the Arizona peace officer standards and training board,

1 and ANY other state, federal, tribal, city or county ~~officers~~ OFFICER WHO
2 IS vested by law with a duty to maintain public order and make arrests.

3 Sec. 2. Eligibility; reimbursement for 2023-2024 and
4 2024-2025 school years; delayed repeal

5 A. Beginning July 1, 2023, a person who meets the requirements
6 prescribed in section 15-1808, subsections B and C, Arizona Revised
7 Statutes, as added by this act, is eligible to receive a tuition waiver
8 scholarship as prescribed in this act regardless of the date on which the
9 eligible person's parent or spouse suffered the posttraumatic stress
10 injury or died by suicide.

11 B. A person who is eligible to receive a tuition waiver scholarship
12 pursuant to subsection A of this section and who did not receive a tuition
13 waiver scholarship pursuant to section 15-1808, Arizona Revised Statutes,
14 during either the 2023-2024 or 2024-2025 school year, or both, is eligible
15 for reimbursement from the Arizona board of regents or the community
16 college district, whichever applies, in an amount equal to the tuition
17 waiver scholarship award that the person was eligible to receive for each
18 school year, minus any gifts, grants, scholarships or other tuition
19 benefits that the person received during each school year.

20 C. This section is repealed from and after December 31, 2028.

21 Sec. 3. Retroactivity

22 This act applies retroactively to from and after June 30, 2023.
