HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AMENDMENTS TO S.B. 1088
(Reference to Senate engrossed bill)

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert:

2 "Section 1. Section 28-1595, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 28-1595. Failure to stop or provide driver license or evidence
5 of identity; violation; classification

6 A. The operator of a motor vehicle who knowingly fails or refuses to
7 bring the operator's motor vehicle to a stop after being given a visual or
8 audible signal or instruction by a peace officer or duly authorized agent
9 of a traffic enforcement agency is guilty of a class 2 misdemeanor.

10 B. After stopping as required by subsection A of this section, the
11 operator of a motor vehicle who fails or refuses to exhibit the operator's
12 driver license as required by section 28-3169 or a driver who is not
13 licensed and who fails or refuses to provide evidence of the driver's
14 identity on request is guilty of a class 2 misdemeanor. The evidence of
15 identity that is presented shall contain all of the following information:

1. The driver's full name.
 2. The driver's date of birth.
 3. The driver's residence address.

19 4. A brief physical description of the driver, including the
20 driver's sex, weight, height and eye and hair color.

- ## 5. The driver's signature.

22 C. A person other than the driver of a motor vehicle who ~~fails or~~
23 refuses to provide ~~evidence of~~ the person's ~~identity~~ FULL NAME, DATE OF

1 BIRTH AND RESIDENCE ADDRESS to a peace officer or a duly authorized agent
2 of a traffic enforcement agency on request, when such officer or agent has
3 reasonable cause to believe the person has committed a violation of this
4 title. ~~—~~ A PERSON WHO FAILS TO COMPLY WITH THIS SUBSECTION is guilty of a
5 class 2 misdemeanor.

6 D. A peace officer or duly authorized agent of a traffic enforcement
7 agency may give the signal or instruction required by subsection A of this
8 section by hand, emergency light, voice, whistle or siren.

9 E. A person shall not be convicted of a violation of subsection B of
10 this section if the person provided evidence of identity required by
11 subsection B, paragraphs 1 through 5 of this section and produces to the
12 court a legible driver license or an authorized duplicate of the license
13 that is issued to the person and that was valid at the time the violation
14 of subsection B of this section occurred."
