1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert:

2 "Section 1. Section 16-541, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 16-541. Absentee voting: voter eligibility

5 A. Any election called pursuant to the laws of this state shall
6 provide for ~~early~~ ABSENTEE voting, including voting by the use of an
7 accessible vote by United States mail option for persons who are blind or
8 have a visual impairment. Any qualified ~~elector~~ VOTER WHO MEETS THE
9 CRITERIA ESTABLISHED BY THIS SECTION may vote by ~~early~~ ABSENTEE ballot.

10 B. A VOTER SHALL BE ALLOWED TO VOTE BY ABSENTEE BALLOT FOR ANY ONE
11 OR MORE OF THE FOLLOWING REASONS:

12 1. THE VOTER EXPECTS TO BE OUTSIDE THIS STATE AT THE TIME OF THE
13 ELECTION.

14 2. THE VOTER IS PHYSICALLY UNABLE TO GO TO THE POLLS BECAUSE THE
15 VOTER IS HOSPITALIZED OR IN A NURSING HOME.

16 3. THE VOTER HAS A VISUAL IMPAIRMENT.

17 4. THE VOTER IS AN ABSENT UNIFORMED SERVICES VOTER OR OVERSEAS VOTER
18 AS DEFINED IN THE UNIFORMED AND OVERSEAS CITIZENS ABSENTEE VOTING ACT (P.L.

1 99-410; 52 UNITED STATES CODE SECTION 20310) OR A SPOUSE OR HOUSEHOLD
2 MEMBER OF THE ABSENT UNIFORMED SERVICES VOTER OR OVERSEAS VOTER.

3 **C.** A qualified elector of a special district organized pursuant
4 to title 48 shall be permitted to vote early in any special district mail
5 ballot election as provided in article 8.1 of this chapter."
