AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 38-201, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO PUBLIC OFFICER QUALIFICATIONS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 38-201, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to
3 read:

4 38-201. General qualifications

5 A. Every officer shall be ~~not less than~~ AT LEAST eighteen years of
6 age, a citizen of the United States and a resident of this state, EXCEPT
7 THAT THE DEPUTY OR ASSISTANT OF AN ELECTED OFFICER IS NOT REQUIRED TO BE A
8 RESIDENT OF THIS STATE.

9 B. ~~No~~ A person is NOT eligible to any office, employment or service
10 in any public institution in ~~the~~ THIS state, or in any of the several
11 counties ~~thereof,~~ OF THIS STATE of any kind or character, whether by
12 election, appointment or contract, unless ~~he~~ THE PERSON is a citizen of
13 the United States, but ~~the provisions of~~ this subsection ~~shall~~ DOES not
14 apply to the employment of any teacher, instructor or professor authorized
15 to teach in the United States under the teacher exchange program as
16 provided by federal statutes or the employment of university or college
17 faculty members.

18 C. A person who is unable to speak, write and read the English
19 language is not eligible to hold a state, county, city, town or precinct
20 office in the state, whether elective or appointive, and ~~no~~ A certificate
21 of election or commission shall NOT issue to a person so disqualified.

22 D. Except as provided in subsection E OF THIS SECTION, a person is
23 not eligible for employment by or service for ~~the~~ THIS state or a
24 political subdivision of ~~the~~ THIS state, including all boards and
25 commissions of ~~the~~ THIS state or A political subdivision, OF THIS STATE
26 AND all multimember governing bodies of departments, agencies,
27 institutions and instrumentalities of ~~the~~ THIS state or political
28 subdivisions OF THIS STATE unless the person has registered with the
29 selective service system if required by the federal military selective
30 service act (62 Stat. 604; 50 United States Code App. section 453).

31 E. A person may not be denied a right, privilege or benefit by
32 reason of subsection D OF THIS SECTION if either of the following applies:

33 1. The requirement for the person to so register has terminated or
34 become inapplicable to the person.

35 2. The person shows by a preponderance of the evidence that the
36 failure of the person to register with the selective service system was
37 not a knowing and ~~wilful~~ WILFUL failure to register.
